June 2-3, Cane Bay, Soccer Camp

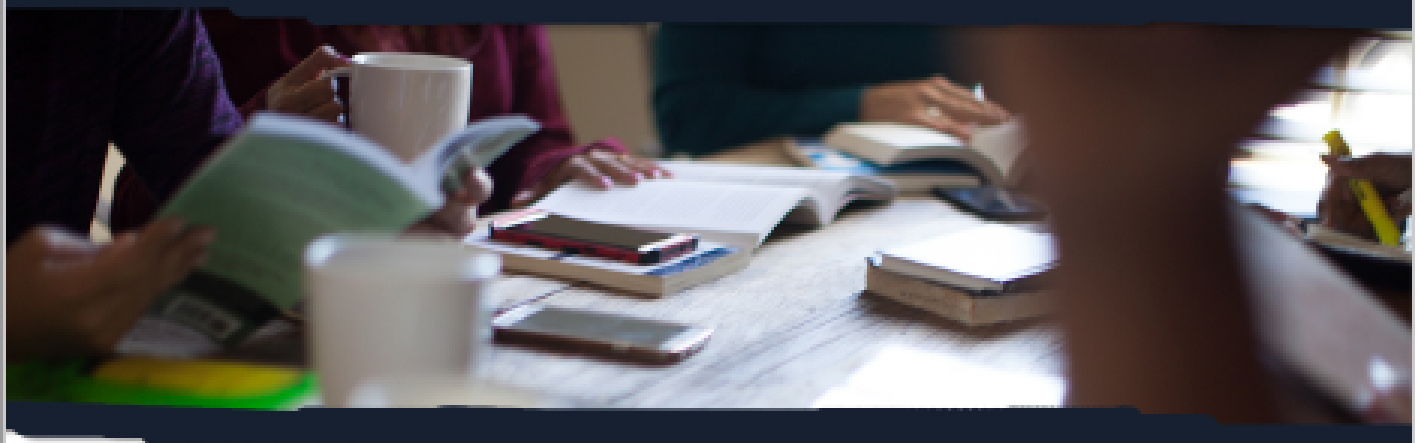
June 5-9, Bonneau, Baseball, Softball, Soccer and Basketball Camp with VBS in the afternoon
